#### Rules, Eligibility and Qualifying Classes

A select number of classes at this show are run under The Friendly Showing Society (TFSS) Official Rulebook (v1.0, effective from 20 January 2026).

By entering, all competitors confirm that they have read, understood, and agree to abide by the TFSS Rules and the conditions set out in this schedule. The TFSS Rulebook applies in full unless otherwise stated within this schedule. In all matters of welfare, safety, eligibility, and conduct, TFSS Rules take precedence.

## **TFSS Qualifying Classes**

The following classes are offered as TFSS qualifiers, in-hand and/or ridden:

CLASSES TO BE HELD IN THE INHAND RING PRIOR TO INHAND CLASSES  
COMMENCING

- **In hand Open Coloured Horse or Pony (Open to all coloured horses or ponies)**
- **In hand Open Mountain and Moorland (Open to all breeds mountain and moorland, shown in accordance to breed standards)**
- **In hand Veteran Horse or Pony (Open to all horses and ponies aged 15 years or over, shown with consideration of age, fitness and welfare)**
- **Ridden Open Coloured Horse or Pony (Open to all coloured horses or ponies, non lead rein and lead rein)**
- **Ridden Open Hunter (Horses and ponies of hunter type, including lightweight, middleweight and heavyweight types)**
- **Ridden Open Mountain and Moorland (Open to all breeds mountain and moorland, shown in accordance to breed standards)**
- **Ridden Veteran Horse or Pony (Open to all horses and ponies aged 15 years or over, shown with consideration of age, fitness and welfare, lead rein and non lead rein)**

## **Qualification**

- **1st place qualifies**
- **2nd place qualifies only if 1st has already qualified**
- **Qualifications do not automatically pass down the line**
- **Qualification may be withheld if, in the Judge's opinion, the required standard has not been met**
- **Qualification is horse or pony specific and not transferable**

**The Judge's decision is final.**

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that qualification cards are correctly completed, signed, and dated by the Judge, and that a clear copy of the horse or pony's passport identification page is submitted in accordance with TFSS instructions.

TFSS accepts no responsibility for missing, incomplete, or incorrectly submitted documentation.

### **Horse Welfare**

Horse welfare is the overriding principle at all TFSS-affiliated competitions.

The Judge, Steward, or Show Officials reserve the right to:

- Inspect tack, bits, spurs, and equipment at any time
- Eliminate competitors where welfare or safety is compromised
- Refuse entry to, or remove, any horse or pony deemed unfit, distressed, lame, exhausted, or unsafe

In the interests of safety and welfare, any fall of horse, rider, or handler will result in immediate disqualification. The

Judge's decision is final.

### **Eligibility**

- Horses and ponies must be four years old or over to compete in both in-hand and ridden classes
- Stallions are permitted unless otherwise stated in the schedule and must be correctly registered and handled or ridden by a competent adult
- Junior competitors may not ride or handle stallions

Any additional eligibility requirements will be stated in the individual class description.

### **Tack and Equipment**

All tack must be safe, correctly fitted, and appropriate to the class.

Training aids are not permitted in the competition ring.

Any tack, bit, or equipment deemed inappropriate by the Judge or Steward may be prohibited.

### **Judges and Stewards**

All Judges officiating at TFSS qualifying classes must be members of the TFSS Approved Judges Panel.

Stewards act on behalf of TFSS and have authority to enforce the Rules in the interests of welfare and safety.

All judging decisions are final.

### **Conduct, Behaviour and Social Media**

Abuse of horses, officials, judges, stewards, volunteers, or competitors will not be tolerated.

Unsporting behaviour, including defamatory, abusive, or inflammatory comments made online by competitors or their

associates acting on their behalf, which are likely to bring TFSS, its officials, or its competitions into disrepute, may be treated as a breach of TFSS Rules.

TFSS reserves the right to issue warnings, eliminate competitors, withdraw qualification, or refuse future participation.

## **RING ONE – WORKING HUNTER RING. Start Time 9:30am**

CLASS No

- ★ 1. Lead Rein working Hunter – Pony to be 128cm and under, rider not to have attained their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year, max height 30cm
- ★ 2. Cradle Stakes Working Hunter - Pony to be 128cm and under, rider not to have attained their 11<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year, max height 45cm
3. 55cm Workers Stakes – Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony. Max height 55cm
4. 65cm Workers Stakes -- Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony. Max height 65cm

### **APPROX TIME OF LUNCH BREAK 30 MINS (TBD on the day)**

- ★ 5. M&M or Plaited Pony under 133cm, rider any age, max height 70cm (for STARS qualifications - ponies must be under 133cm plaited/hogged & M&Ms registered with the relevant society).
- ★ 6. 75cm workers stakes – Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height (for STARS qualifications only, – plaited horses/ponies exceeding 133 not to exceed 153cm & will jump 80cm at STARS).
- ★ 7. M&M or Plaited Pony over 133cm –rider any age, max height 85cm. (for STARS qualifications, – plaited or hogged horses/ponies not to exceed 153cm & will jump 80cm at STARS. M&M ponies registered with relevant society with no upper height limit and will jump 85cm at STARS).
- ★ 8. 95cms Worker Stakes – Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony. (for STARS qualifications only – horses to exceed 153cm plaited/hogged)

## **RING 2 – EQUITATION RING. Start Time 9:00am**

CLASS No

- ★ 9. Best Turned Out – To be shown mounted or unmounted, any breed/type of horse/pony. Any age rider/handler.
  - ★ 10. Senior Equitation – Riders to have attained 18th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridles only.
  - ★ 11. Junior Equitation – Riders not to have attained 18th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridles only.
  - ★ 12. First Ridden Equitation – Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridles only.
  - ★ 13. Lead Rein Equitation – Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband.
  - 14. **NEW** Have a go off the lead rein equitation - Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Parents can support in the ring. Any riding bit allowed.
  - 15. Starter Ridden Equitation – For genuine novice/nervous riders of any age. Go round in walk and trot and optional canter in individual show. You cannot enter any other equitation class if entering this class and only eligible for one season only. Snaffle bridles only.
- APPROX TIME OF LUNCH BREAK 30 MINS (TBD on the day)**
- ★ 16. Riding Club Horse / Riding Club Pony – Riders any age, may include a small jump/obstacle. This class may be split depending on entries.
  - 17. Novice Horse or Pony – Open to Rider any age, Horse or pony any age, type or height, but must be suitably mounted. Combination to have won no more than 3 firsts in any season to enter. Snaffle Bridles only.
  - 37. Senior Handler – Handlers to be 18 years and over on the 1st January of the current year.
  - ★ 38. Junior Handler – Handlers to have obtained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday but not their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year. Horse or pony any height.
  - ★ 39. Young Handler – Handlers to have obtained their 8<sup>th</sup> birthday but not their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1st January in current year. Horse or pony any height.
  - ★ 40. Tiny Tots Handler – Handlers to have attained their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, but not their 8<sup>th</sup> birthday by the 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year. Pony to not exceed 128cm. Handlers **MUST** be

accompanied by an adult but adult must not assist unless handler is in difficulty. Ponies must be suitable for the child. (May be combined with class 41 but placed separately depending on entry numbers)

### **RING 3 RIDDEN SHOWING start time 9.00am**

- ★ 18. Ridden Show Horse (Hack/Riding Horse/ROR) – Horses to exceed 148 cms. to be shown plaited and trimmed. (class may be split depending on entry numbers)
- ★ 19. Ridden Show Cob/Hunter - Hunters to exceed 148cms, to be shown plaited and trimmed. Show Cobs to be shown hogged and trimmed. (class may be split depending on entry numbers)
- ★ 20. Ridden Coloured – Open to horse/pony. (Plaited/Native/Traditional inc solid traditional (points to be awarded points according to type, class may be split depending on entry numbers)
- ★ 21. Ridden Veteran – Lead Rein allowed. Open to all breed types of horse/pony age 14 years and above.

### **APPROX TIME OF LUNCH BREAK 30 MINS (TBD on the day)**

- ★ 22. Ridden Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony - Show Pony not to exceed 148cms and Show Hunter Pony not to exceed 158cm.
- ★ 23. Lead Rein M & M, Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridle only. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband.
- ★ 24. First Ridden M & M. Rider not to have attained 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
- ★ 25. Lead Rein Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony, Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridle only. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband.
- ★ 26. First Ridden Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony. Rider not to have attained 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
- ★ 27. Open Ridden Registered Small Breeds M & M - Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- ★ 28. Open Ridden Registered Large Breeds M & M – Must be registered with the relevant breed society.

## **RING 4 – IN HAND SHOWING RING. Start Time 9:00am**

### **CLASS No 51 – 57 Will be judged by TFSS Panel Judge Johnny Simpson**

49. **TFSS Qualifier** In hand Open Coloured Horse or Pony (Open to all coloured horses or ponies)
50. **TFSS Qualifier** In hand Open Mountain and Moorland (Open to all breeds mountain and moorland, shown in accordance to breed standards)
51. **TFSS Qualifier** In hand Veteran Horse or Pony (Open to all horses and ponies aged 15 years or over, shown with consideration of age, fitness and welfare)
52. **TFSS Qualifier** Ridden Open Coloured Horse or Pony (Open to all coloured horses or ponies, non lead rein and lead rein)
53. **TFSS Qualifier** Ridden Open Hunter (Horses and ponies of hunter type, including lightweight, middleweight and heavyweight types)
54. **TFSS Qualifier** Ridden Open Mountain and Moorland (Open to all breeds mountain and moorland, shown in accordance to breed standards)
55. **TFSS Qualifier** Ridden Veteran Horse or Pony (Open to all horses and ponies aged 15 years or over, shown with consideration of age, fitness and welfare, lead rein and non lead rein)

- ★ 29. Youngstock – Open to foals and youngstock 3 years and under. Any breed/type. Filly, colt, or gelding. Colts to be handled by a competent person aged 16 years or over.
- ★ 30. In-Hand Show Horse (Hack/Riding Horse/ROR) – Show horses to exceed 148cms. To be shown plaited and trimmed.
- ★ 31. In-Hand Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony – To be shown plaited and trimmed. Open to show ponies not exceeding 148cms, and show hunter ponies not exceeding 158cm.
- ★ 32. In-Hand Registered M & M Large Breeds – Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- ★ 33. In-Hand Registered M & M Small Breeds. Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- ★ 34. In-Hand Show Hunter/Show Cob – Hunters to exceed 148cms to be shown plaited and trimmed. Show Cobs to be shown hogged and trimmed.
- ★ 35. In-Hand Veteran – Open to all breed types of horse/ponies, age 14 years and above.
- ★ 36. In-Hand Coloured - Open to horse/pony. Plaited/Native/Traditional & solid traditional (points will be awarded according to type)

41. In-Hand Best Condition – Open to any breed/Type/Age/Horse/Pony.
