CLASS PRE-ENTRY PRICES ARE £7 MEMBERS, £10 NON MEMBERS VIA BACS
(CLASSES ENTERED ON THE DAY WILL BE CHARGED AT £9 FOR MEMBERS AND £12 FOR NON-MEMBERS.

EACH MEMBER WILL BE ALLOCATED A BACK NUMBER FOR THE SEASON – THIS CAN BE COLLECTED AT THE FIRST SHOW FROM THE CARAVAN BUT WILL BE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO REPLACE IF LOST OR DAMAGED.

EXCLUDING LEAD REIN & FIRST RIDDEN CLASSES WHERE ALL COMPETITORS WILL RECEIVE A ROSETTE, PLACINGS TO 4TH PLACE ONLY IN EACH CLASS.

EACH MEMBER GAINS 1 POINT PER CLASS FOR ENTERING, WHICH WILL GO TOWARDS END OF SEASON, AGE AND OVERALL POINTS.

CHAMPIONSHIP SASH SHOW - A SASH WILL BE AWARDED TO THE WINNER OF EACH CLASS WHO MUST HAVE BEEN A MEMBER PRIOR TO THE FIRST SHOW TO BE AWARDED A SASH.

THE COMMITTEE, JUDGES AND SHOW OFFICIALS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SPLIT OR AMALGAMATE CLASSES AT THEIR DISCRETION.

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO BE AT YOUR RING, AND IN YOUR CLASS, AT THE CORRECT TIME, IF IN THE EVENT OF A CLASS CLASHING, YOU MUST INFORM THE STEWARD OF THE RING, IT WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGE AS TO WHETHER THE RING WILL BE HELD.

RING ONE – WORKING HUNTER RING. Start Time 9:30am

- ★ 1. **NEW** Lead Rein working Hunter – Pony to be 128cm and under, rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year, max height 30cm
- ★ 2. Tiny Tots Working Hunter - Pony to be 128cm and under, rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year, max height 40cm
- 3. Nursery Stakes – Pony to be 133 and under, M&M, hogged or plaited. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Max height 50cm
- 4. Novice Horse/Pony workers stakes – Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height, max height 55cm
- ★ 5. **NEW** M&M Pony under 133cm – pony to be registered with relevant society, rider any age, max height 60cm

APPROX TIME OF LUNCH BREAK 30 MINS (TBD on the day)


- ★ 6. 65cm workers stakes – Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height (for STARS qualifications only - ponies must be under 133cm plaited/hogged)
- ★ 7. **NEW** M&M Pony over 133cm – pony to be registered with the relevant society, rider any age, max height 75cm.
- ★ 8. 75cms Worker Stakes – Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony. (for STARS qualifications only - ponies must be over 133 & under 153cm plaited/hogged)
- ★ 9. 85cms Worker Stakes – Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony. (for STARS qualifications only – horses to exceed 153cm plaited/hogged)
- ★ 10. 95cms Worker Stakes – Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony. (for STARS qualifications only – horses to exceed 153cm plaited/hogged)

RING 2 – EQUITATION RING. Start Time 9:00am

-  11. Best Turned Out – To be shown mounted or unmounted, any breed/type of horse/pony. Any age rider/handler.
-  12. Senior Equitation – Riders to have attained 18th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridles only.
-  13. Junior Equitation – Riders not to have attained 18th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridles only.
-  14. First Ridden Equitation – Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridles only.
-  15. Lead Rein Equitation – Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband.
- 16. **NEW** Have a go off the lead rein equitation - Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Parents can support in the ring. Any riding bit allowed.

APPROX TIME OF LUNCH BREAK 30 MINS (TBD on the day)

- 17. Starter Ridden Equitation – For genuine novice/nervous riders of any age. Go round in walk and trot and optional canter in individual show. You cannot enter any other equitation class if entering this class and only eligible for one season only. Snaffle bridles only.
-  18. Riding Club Horse / Riding Club Pony – Riders any age, may include a small jump/obstacle. This class may be split depending on entries.

RING 3 RIDDEN SHOWING start time 9.00am

19. Novice Horse or Pony – Open to Rider any age, Horse or pony any age, type or height, but must be suitably mounted. Combination to have won no more than 3 firsts in any season to enter. Snaffle Bridles only.

- ★ 20. Ridden Show Horse (Hack/Riding Horse/ROR) – Horses to exceed 148 cms. to be shown plaited and trimmed. (class may be split depending on entry numbers)
- ★ 21. Ridden Show Cob/Hunter - Hunters to exceed 148cms, to be shown plaited and trimmed. Show Cobs to be shown hogged and trimmed. (class may be split depending on entry numbers)
- ★ 22. Ridden Coloured – Open to horse/pony. (Plaited/Native/Traditional inc solid traditional (points to be awarded points according to type, class may be split depending on entry numbers)
- ★ 23. Ridden Veteran – Lead Rein allowed. Open to all breed types of horse/pony age 14 years and above.
- ★ 24. Ridden Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony - Show Pony not to exceed 148cms and Show Hunter Pony not to exceed 158cm.

APPROX TIME OF LUNCH BREAK 30 MINS (TBD on the day)

- ★ 25. Lead Rein M & M, Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridle only. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband.
- ★ 26. First Ridden M & M. Rider not to have attained 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
- ★ 27. Lead Rein Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony, Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridle only. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband.
- ★ 28. First Ridden Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony. Rider not to have attained 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
- ★ 29. Open Ridden Registered Small Breeds M & M - Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- ★ 30. Open Ridden Registered Large Breeds M & M – Must be registered with the relevant breed society.

RING 4 – IN HAND SHOWING RING. Start Time 9:00am

CLASS No

- ★ 31. Youngstock – Open to foals and youngstock 3 years and under. Any breed/type. Filly, colt, or gelding. Colts to be handled by a competent person aged 16 years or over.
- ★ 32. In-Hand Show Horse (Hack/Riding Horse/ROR) – Show horses to exceed 148cms. To be shown plaited and trimmed.
- ★ 33. In-Hand Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony – To be shown plaited and trimmed. Open to show ponies not exceeding 148cms, and show hunter ponies not exceeding 158cm.
- ★ 34. In-Hand Registered M & M Large Breeds – Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- ★ 35. In-Hand Registered M & M Small Breeds. Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- ★ 36. In-Hand Show Hunter/Show Cob – Hunters to exceed 148cms to be shown plaited and trimmed. Show Cobs to be shown hogged and trimmed.
- ★ 37. In-Hand Veteran – Open to all breed types of horse/ponies, age 14 years and above.
- ★ 38. In-Hand Coloured - Open to horse/pony. Plaited/Native/Traditional & solid traditional (points will be awarded according to type)

APPROX TIME OF LUNCH BREAK 30 MINS (TBD on the day)

- 39. Senior Handler – Handlers to be 18 years and over on the 1st January of the current year.
- ★ 40. Junior Handler – Handlers to have obtained their 12th birthday but not their 18th birthday before the 1st January in current year. Horse or pony any height.
- ★ 41. Young Handler – Handlers to have obtained their 8th birthday but not their 12th birthday before the 1st January in current year. Horse or pony any height.
- ★ **42. NEW** Tiny Tots Handler – Handlers to have attained their 4th birthday, but not their 8th birthday by the 1st January in current year. Pony to not exceed 128cm. Handlers **MUST** be accompanied by an adult but adult must not assist unless handler is in difficulty. Ponies must be suitable for the child. (May be combined with class 41 but placed separately depending on entry numbers)
- 43. In-Hand Best Condition – Open to any breed/Type/Age/Horse/Pony.

RING 5 - SHOW JUMPING 10AM start

Clear Round 9:30am-10AM £3 per round.
